6. Staff Reports

6.1 Current Programming at Arena and Rec Center

The rec center currently has shuffleboard on Monday and Thursday mornings, pickleball on Tuesday and Thursday evenings, and cornhole on Friday evenings. The arena has public skating on Saturday's and between Christmas/new years, and march break from 1-2:30pm. All skates have been sponsored this season, and have a waiting list too. There is a list of businesses and service clubs that we reach out to, but the arena has a reduced rate, which makes it easier to find sponsors.

6.2 Pool attendance and survey results

There was great feedback from the survey. Things that staff will look into for budget is putting a cover over the existing benches, as well as the potential to add more benches. An idea was something similar to what Dutton has (bleachers under cover). Some programming ideas were a teen swim on Friday's, lane swim during aquafit, and an exercise swim. For lessons, look to move to the evening instead of the afternoon, and have times already scheduled so parents know roughly when the kids would have their lessons before signing up. In February the job postings usually go out for the lifeguards, and they said they were looking to return next year, and may have some new applicants from Dutton as well.

7. New Business

7.1 Future programming ideas

Some new ideas are a running and hiking group as well as some kid driven activities. The committee would like to have a rec person in place to implement and organize these ideas before bringing more ideas to the table.

7.2 Canada day grant

Looking at the survey results, there are some accommodations we might want to implement for 2025. Some ideas are to have the festivities later in the day, more food trucks, seeing if the Knights of Columbus can have their fish fry at the arena, petting zoo, agility dogs, comedian/magician, trunk/book sale, and vendors. Want advertising to happen sooner and look for volunteers earlier. Dance, face painting and fireworks were well liked. The option for the use of the arena will depend on the dehumidification system, and Terri will bring this timeline back to the next meeting, as some thoughts were a ball hockey/skills competition, or the option to have things under cover if the weather is not favorable. Grant is submitted the end of November and find out in March/April if we are approved.

7.3 Recreation Coordinator

It was in agreeance that the rec coordinator would develop a recreation plan, organize activities, look at different age groups for programming and wants, and find creative ways to utilize all the centers. The letter would like to be changed so that the main focus items are at the top of the list, with the administrative tasks after the main purpose. The letter will then be presented to council at the next meeting.

7.4 Ontario Trillium Grant

There is 3 different grants available - grow, capital, and seed grant. The grow grant is for increasing a program, or adding a new program that has been proven to be successful elsewhere. The capital grant would be for major capital budget items. The committee should have some ideas together for when these become available every year, so the quotes get updated and it is ready to be submitted. Some ideas were to pave the path in miller park and focus on the accessibility aspect of this. Another idea was to have port-a-potties in the community for those that are visiting the area, and businesses will not let them use the washrooms.

7.5 Terms of Reference

Everyone was ok with the new version proposed, and can be changed if we get a rec coordinator to include their duties within the committee.

7.6 Additional Items

The committee would like to discuss the 2025 fees and charges at the next meeting to start assisting with budget talks. Pickleball was looking for a seasonal pass, and might be something to look into for other programs too. There is the ad out for recruitment for the committee, and Taraesa is

going to reach out to the high school to see if anyone might be interested for the student vacancy.
